BACKGROUND

The Courance Farm is owned by Alister and Anne Jack and managed by Raymond McKerlie.

Until 2014 it was a beef suckler unit of 300 pure Simmentals. These were disposed of between April and June of that year.

In preparation for the dairy herd, a major investment of £800,000 was spent in remodelling the existing beef sheds.

ALTITUDE

Altitude is between 100-150 m.

RAINFALL

Rainfall average approximately 610 mm.

CROPPING

Courance extends to

1118 acres owned

200 rented

Silage: 200 acres cut twice

100 acres third cut

Cereals: 129 acres Wholecrop

70 acres cereal

THE DAIRY HERD

On the 22nd July 2014 the unit started milk production with the purchase of 90 black and white Dutch cows and 90 in calf heifers. These were milked with 3 Lely A4 astronauts.

In April 2015 another three Lely A4 robots were installed and the cow numbers increased to 300.

Cows calve all the year round, and are currently averaging 25.2 litres with a calving index of 407 days.

Milk protein: 3.32 Butter Fat: 4.18

DAIRY COW RATION

For maintenance plus 16kg.

46 kg silage 1st cut

1.5 kg hay

3.5 blend

7kg arable silage

The milk is sold to Graham Dairies.

SILAGE MAKING

Target cutting date is 21st May, with a contractor employed to do the whole operation.

HOUSING

Cows are all bedded on green bedding and are kept indoors 365 days of the year. The dry cows are grazed during the summer.

THE TEAM

Niall, the herdsman is responsible for the day to day running of the dairy cows.

The dairy cow nutrition is managed by Ros Hughes of Kite Consulting.

GRASS

Grass seed is supplied by Watson Seeds, using their high yielding, later maturing Duart grass mixture.
